We wish to thank all our friends and partners for supporting us big time to fulfil our 2022 goals and objectives. This year was a big year for us where we registered a lot of progress in our work both at our centre and within the communities where we serve. Many good things have happened and just a few are outlined below:

1. More than 3,000 small-scale farmers were reached and taught how to raise their own food using highly productive, sustainable agriculture techniques (GROW BIOINTENSIVE). These farmers were drawn from 3 counties of Muranga, Kiambu and Machakos where majority of farmers came from Machakos county. The support came from The Tudor Trust of the UK, Ecology Action of USA, The Buddhist Global Relief fund and Kilili Self Help project
2. 30 students were enrolled in the Girls Empowerment Program at G-BiACK which is a multi-disciplinary program that provides a safe community and opportunities for girls and young women to access their rights, obtain an education, experience economic success and become leaders in their own communities. Thank you Amistad international and Connection Ubuntu for the support
3. Through the support from Amistad International, we were able to construct a new dining hall, spacious enough to accommodate at least 50 people.
4. Miva Switzerland in partnership with Kilili Self Help Project USA supported G-BiACK to procure a double-cub vehicle which is being used for community services where G-BiACK is working.
5. G-BiACK Won the 2022 indigenous seeds and food culture fair held at the museum of Kenya from October 12th - 14th 2022.

We highly believe that 2023 will be even better. We wish to welcome more partners to help us meet our goals and objectives.
