The GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture Centre of Kenya (G-BIACK) was founded ten years ago by husband and wife Samuel and Peris Nderitu, with the goal of reducing extreme poverty and improving the living standards of resource poor communities. Promoting ecologically viable development strategies for sustainable and quality livelihoods, G-BIACK has managed to train over 17,000 small holder farmers in Kenya, giving them skills that enable them to grow sufficient, clean food from their small family farms, and excess crops for market.

Striving to be an action-oriented, practical, and visionary organization, G-BIACK has helped many Kenyan communities and small-scale farmers to raise their own food using sustainable, highly productive agriculture techniques to address food insecurity, health issues, and poverty.

G-BIACK also provides separate women's programs to specifically help this often-marginalized group in the society. Special life-skills courses are provided for women and girls, including widows and others impoverished by the effects of HIV/AIDS in their families. These programs teach nutrition and health and a variety of empowering, practical income generation skills, such as sewing, beadwork, soap making, baking, solar cooking, basic computer and more.
