Despite the COVID 19 pandemic that affected normal operations of many companies and organizations all over the world, the GROW BIOINTENSIVE Agriculture Centre of Kenya (G-BIACK) continued to work with small holder food producers in Kenya and in neighboring countries, by helping them to use sustainable, organic, ecological food producing methods that produce more food for less cost. In so doing, the farmers were able to mitigate the COVID19 pandemic by producing clean, healthy and highly nutritious food to fight the pandemic with nutrition.

G-BIACK centre was selected by one of the biggest networks in Kenya known as Participatory Ecological Land Use Management PELUM in partnership with Bioivision Africa Trust to become the Ecological Agriculture Demonstration farm for Kenya and centre of excellence, where farmers visit to see and to learn interventions that are farmer- and environment-friendly, and simple to implement.

Besides training thousands of farmers this year, G-BIACK also participated in events that brought farmers together where different agricultural technologies were showcased. This is our third win in a row since this event began in 2019.
