Many are the times when children with special needs are withdrawn from the public sphere because most people do not want to associate with them. Some of them are abandoned even by their parents. Such children end up in orphanages and children centres. G-BIACK sees children with special needs having human rights equal to any other citizen. We therefore work and partner with other like-minded individuals and organizations to ensure that these children may have healthy, sufficient and quality food through the creation of Biointensive gardens

Through Biointensive techniques, schools, children homes and institutions such as orphanages, schools for children with special needs and rescue centers among can be in a position to sustainably grow enough food to cater for their nutritional needs.

During the month of October, G-BIACK identified the Ezekiel special school where children are faced with multiple defects; not able to walk or to talk. The children are 20 in number and only 3 have wheelchairs. The rest can only be carried by their assistants from one place to another. Access to healthy food is a big problem for Ezekiel School and that is why G-BIACK opted to assist them to create a Biointensive garden. These are our brothers and sisters. They are our children!
